What are Healthcare Coalition's and what do we do?

Healthcare Coalitions are a collaborative network of organizations (Hospitals, Public Health, Emergency Management, EMS, and many others) consisting of public and private response partners. They serve as a multiagency coordinating group (MAC) that assists in responding to disasters and emergency situations through communication and coordination. They focus on relationship building and collaboration, to develop and facilitate a coordinated healthcare response to disasters and emergencies in an all-hazards approach, while utilizing resources and healthcare preparedness to meet the health and medical needs of the community during an emergency.
